Large crowds are expected to attend the 51st NSW Aboriginal Rugby League Knockout! We look forward to welcoming visitors to our region for this significant rugby league event.

The best way to get to the 2023 event is by train. Trains to Tuggerah are on the Sydney/Central Coast/Newcastle line. The station is a short walk (300m) to the sporting complex on Lake Road. Passenger bus services will continue to operate as normal but please note the routing for Red Bus services to and from Tuggerah Station.

CDC Buses will provide shuttle transfers between EDSACC Bateau Bay and Tuggerah Dog Park operating as a Park n Ride to and from CCRSRC. Parking around the venue is limited and traffic is expected to be heavy over the weekend. If you have to drive, allow extra time, arrive early, use the Park n Ride shuttle transfer and carpool where possible.

CHANGED ROAD CONDITIONS and PARKING INFORMATION

- 1. EDSACC Bateau Bay (Route 1) 2 shuttle service (enter via Yakalla Street) will depart every hour, on the hour, with returns from the CCRSRC on the half hour, every hour commencing 8am, with the last return shuttle leaving from the CCRSRC at 7pm.
- 2. Bryant Drive will be subject to a number of traffic control procedures to minimise vehicle and pedestrian conflict and motorists are asked to proceed with extreme caution.
- 3. Tuggerah Dog Park (Route 2) (4), will operate as a Park n Ride public parking location (closed in the event of inclement weather). The shuttle service will depart every 15/20 minutes from 8am with the last return shuttle leaving the CCRSRC at 7pm.
- 4. The Red Bus route has altered to provide passage, drop-off and pickup on the western side (Pacific Highway) of Tuggerah Railway station for the duration of the event.
- 5. Tuggerah Dog Park Shuttle Buses people are encouraged to catch the shuttle bus service from the designated drop off/pickup location rather than walk to CCRSRC grounds to minimise vehicle and pedestrian conflict. Motorists are asked to proceed with extreme caution (see inset map (4))
