Special Disaster Relief Grant (Category D)	Eligible primary producers can apply for grants of up to \$75,000 to assist with clean up, repair of damaged infrastructure, restocking and replanting, replacing lost or damaged assets and restoring operations to pre-disaster levels.	
	Eligible primary producers can access an initial \$5,000 by providing photographic evidence of direct damage, with the remaining funds available once valid tax invoices and proof of payment are submitted and verified.

	Primary producers should report flood-related damage including stock and fodder losses, damage to crops, pastures, fencing and other farm infrastructure through the <u>Natural</u> <u>Disaster Damage Survey</u> .
