Attachment "B" Car Park Terms and Conditions

By entering or using this car park, the driver of the vehicle and any passengers ("you") acknowledge and agree to the following conditions. If you do not agree, you must not enter or must immediately leave the car park.

1. This car park is provided by Central Coast Council ("Council") for the purpose of vehicle parking only and does not include the provision of safety or security for vehicles or their contents.
2. Use of the car park is entirely at your own risk.
3. Drivers are required to comply with all signage, speed limits, traffic controls, applicable road rules, and any reasonable directions given by Council staff, Council authorised contractors, authorised officers, or emergency services.
4. Vehicles must be parked wholly within marked parking bays.
5. Bays reserved for persons with a disability may only be used where a valid Australian Disability Parking Permit is clearly displayed, in accordance with legislation.
6. Fees and charges apply. This is a cashless and ticketless facility. Applicable fees and conditions are displayed on site or available at www.centralcoast.nsw.gov.au.
7. The car park may only be entered during the operating hours displayed on signage at the car park or as otherwise notified by Council. Vehicles may exit the car park outside of operating hours where the car park design or access systems permit, or where authorised by Council.
8. Where a vehicle cannot be exited from the car park outside of operating hours without assistance from Council or its contractors, an after-hours vehicle release fee applies. Any applicable after-hours vehicle release fee must be paid before the vehicle is released.
9. Parking is subject to availability. Entry does not guarantee the availability of a parking space at any time.
10. Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) and Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) systems operate within and around the car park for access control, compliance, enforcement, operational, and security purposes. Personal information collected is handled in accordance with applicable privacy legislation and Central Coast Council Privacy Management Plan Policy and may be disclosed where required or authorised by law. Privacy information is available at www.centralcoast.nsw.gov.au/privacy.
11. Council reserves the right to refuse entry to, or require the removal of, any vehicle, object or person from the car park at any time for operational, safety, security, emergency, capacity, or maintenance reasons, without notice and without liability to Council, except to the extent required by law.
12. Council may enter, move, reposition, or remove a vehicle within or from the car park where reasonably necessary for safety, operational efficiency, compliance, emergency response, maintenance, or where a vehicle is parked in breach of these conditions.
13. Children and animals must not be left unattended in vehicles within the car park.
14. Council may take enforcement action for breaches of these conditions or where required for operational, safety, emergency, or maintenance reasons. Enforcement action may include issuing infringements, applying fees or charges, suspending or cancelling access, commencing proceedings, arranging vehicle removal, and reporting matters to, or seeking assistance from, police or other relevant authorities where appropriate. This may include enforcement action under the Local Government Act 1993 - Sect 632 - Acting contrary to notices erected by councils.

17. Australian Consumer Law guarantees apply. To the extent permitted by law, Council's liability is limited to resupplying the services or paying the cost of doing so.
18. Except where caused by an act or omission of Council, Council is not responsible for loss of or damage to vehicles or their contents.
19. To the extent permitted by law, you release and indemnify Council from and against any claim, loss, damage, liability, cost, or expense arising from or in connection with your use of the car park, except where caused by an act or omission of Council.
20. If any provision of these conditions is found to be invalid or unenforceable, that provision will be severed and the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.
21. These conditions are governed by the laws of New South Wales, and you submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of New South Wales.
